



UCD Societies Council Society Representation

The interests of student societies are represented at a number of levels, usually by the Chair of the Societies Council (as a student representative of overall student society activity), and at times, also by a number of elected Auditors (as student representatives of current student society activities and involvement).

These include committees specific to the work of student societies, and other committees on student activities and student life across the University.

Societies Council

Finance Committee

This is a sub-committee of the Societies Council, which adjudicates on the grant applications made by societies. There are eight Auditors elected onto the committee at the start of each academic year, as well as the Chair of the Societies Council and the Societies Officer.

Auditors must be nominated by another Council member. Constituencies are available on ucdsocieties.com/forms or by contacting the Societies Officer.

Executive Committee

This is the oversight committee of the Societies Council, which is responsible for influencing and informing the development of the Societies Council. It is made up of both current and past representatives of student societies, including: the current Chair & Societies Officer, two previous Chairs, current & previous Auditors who have represented the Council at other committee levels.

Student Consultative Forum

General Assembly

All Society Auditors are members of the Forum General Assembly. Meetings are constituted to be held once a semester. The other members of the Forum include the Captains of all Sports Clubs, the Sabbatical Officers of the Students' Union and members of the Forum's Executive Committee. Issues addressed at the Forum General Assembly are relevant to all parties.

Executive Committee

The Forum Executive is a smaller group which discuss issues before they go to the General Assembly. One Auditor is elected from the Societies Council to sit on this committee, as one of the three Student Society representatives, with the Chair of the Societies Council and the Societies Office being the other two.

Sports Clubhouse Club

Management Committee

The Management Committee are the 'governing body' of the Clubhouse. The committee is formed of staff members and student representatives, who are charged with controlling the business and affairs of the Clubhouse. Student societies are represented by the Societies Officer, as a staff member, and by the Chair of the Societies Council, as a student representative of the Societies Council.

Student societies are represented by the Chair of the Societies Council.
