



Society Representation

The interests of student societies are represented at a number of levels, usually by the Chair of the Societies Council (as a student representative of overall student society activity), and, at times, also by a number of elected Auditors (as student representatives of current student society activities and involvement).

These include committees specific to the work of student societies, and other committees on student activities and student life across the University.

UCD Societies Council

Finance Committee

A sub-committee of the Societies Council, which adjudicates on the grant applications made by student societies, and awards monies made available to student societies from Capitation sums allocated to the Societies Council from the Student Activities Committee.

Constitution UCD Societies Council Constitution

Recognition Committee

A sub-committee of the Societies Council, which adjudicates on applications for recognition for new student societies and approves amendments to the constitutions of current members of the Societies Council, and also has a remit in the discipline of student societies and student society officers.

Executive Committee

This is the oversight and advisory committee of the Societies Council, which is responsible for influencing and informing the development of the Societies Council and student society activity. It is made up of both current and past representatives of student societies, to advise and counsel the officers of the Societies Council.

Management Committee

The Management Committee are the 'governing body' of the Clubhouse. The committee is formed of staff members and student representatives, who are charged with controlling the business and affairs of the Clubhouse.

Student Experience Group

SEG is a reporting group of the UMT, and was established to provide high-level oversight and coordination of student supports. It is made up of a diverse range of representatives from student supports and services, including representatives from IT, Registry, Library, Buildings & Services, SU, Student Advisers, Programme Office Directors and many others.

Student Activities Committee

SAC is an oversight body for the 3 "pillar entities" of student activity in the University – UCD Societies Council, UCD Athletic Union Council, and UCD Students' Union. Considered a successor to the UCD Student Consultative Forum (1990-2016), the group has a wide-scope remit including the allocation of Capitation amongst the entities for further disbursement.
